Sparkling and Champagnes

Prosecco Spumante “Vispo Allegro” VENETO, ITALY

Fruity, lively and clean with surprising depth of flavour. Hints of greengage and lemon.

Le Dolci Colline Prosecco Rosé VENETO, ITALY

A fresh and delicately fruity Prosecco Rosé with red berry and floral aromas. Lively on the palate with ripe strawberry and raspberry notes and a clean, refreshing finish.

Crémant Brut “Carte Azure”, Salasar LIMOUX, FRANCE

Lovely light and refreshing aperitif style wine from Limoux, widely thought to be birthplace of Sparkling wine. Closer in style to Champagne than Prosecco.

Taittinger Brut Réserve CHAMPAGNE, FRANCE

The Brut Réserve NV is Taittinger’s signature cuvée. Bright, delicate and fresh with subtle notes of bread and a fine lingering mousse. A great NV Champagne.

Taittinger Prestige Rosé CHAMPAGNE, FRANCE

Prestige Rose displays charm and subtle harmony of flavours. Its aromas are fresh with wild strawberries and a hint of spice. On the palate this lively, fruity, fresh and elegant wine is balanced and smooth with good length.

Taittinger Brut Vintage CHAMPAGNE, FRANCE

Taittinger produce a vintage champagne only when the harvest has been of exceptional quality. Flint and yeasty bread on the nose, the palate is rich and smooth releasing flavours of sugared pink grapefruit. The finish is long, generous and complex.

Wines from East Anglia

Charmat Rosé, Flint Vineyards NORFOLK, ENGLAND

This lively, innovative blend from award-winning wine maker Ben Witchell is full of strawberry, cranberry, and red cherry flavours, accompanied by a hint of peppery spice.

‘Skylark’ Brut, Chet Valley Vineyard NORFOLK, ENGLAND

A sparkling wine with intensity of flavour showing apple, melon and tropical fruit tempered with the toastiness of the traditional method secondary fermentation in the bottle.

Bacchus Fumé, Flint Vineyard NORFOLK, ENGLAND

This Bacchus is made in a new-world style and is fresh, clean and full of flavour. It is a fantastic alternative to Sauvignon Blanc or Riesling.

Silex Blanc, Flint Vineyard NORFOLK, ENGLAND

This is a complex wine, with breezy floral notes overlaying fresh spice and toasted almond. It is zippy on the palate, clean and linear with good structure.

Pinot Noir Rose, Burn Valley NORFOLK, ENGLAND

Dry style Pinot Noir Rose. Strawberries & cream on the nose, with raspberry and hints of peach and watermelon.

Dry, delicate whites

Loureiro, Casa de Vila Nova SOUSA, PORTUGAL

Ripe citrus and delicately tropical aromas lead onto a textural, mineral palate with bright acidity, fleshy white peach fruit and a fresh, zesty finish.

Pinot Grigio “Conviviale” VENEZIA, ITALY

Ripe orchard fruits on the nose with hints of honey and peach. Lightly spicy with good weight and texture, balanced by fresh acidity.

Picpoul de Pinet “Le Beau Flamant” COTEAUX DU LANGUEDOC, FRANCE

Known as ‘the Chablis of the South’, Picpoul is crisp and dry but with plenty of stone fruit, melon, and tropical fruit.

Pinot Gris “White Label” Allan Scott MARLBOROUGH, NEW ZEALAND

Marlborough Pinot Gris has grown strongly in popularity over the last few years and has quickly become a staple in the Allan Scott Family Winemakers range. This is a wine rich in aroma, flavour and texture.

Sauvignon Blanc/Vermentino “Côté Mas” FRANCE

Complex aromas of flower, peach and pear. Fruity, rich and vivid. Ample, well-balanced and long-lasting.

Zesty, herbaceous or aromatic

Sauvignon Blanc “Riviera” SOUTHERN FRANCE

An easy-drinking fruity and clean Sauvignon Blanc with notes of white flowers and tropical fruits.

Pecorino, Colline Pescaresi ABRUZZO, ITALY

Vibrant aromas of stone fruit with citrus and grapefruit notes. The palate is crisp with layers of fresh peachy, tropical fruit characters. Lively and approachable, with good texture and minerality.

Sauvignon Blanc, Allan Scott Estate MARLBOROUGH, NEW ZEALAND

Allan Scott is a true pioneer of the Marlborough region. This wine is punchy and vibrant with excellent varietal purity, finishing long and refreshing with flavours of apple, nectarine and lime peel.

Albarino “Pazo das Bruxas”, Torres RÍAS BAIXAS, SPAIN

Delicate and fragrant, with lime blossom and lemon marmalade notes. Silky and savoury on the palate, elegantly structured.

Ripe and fruity whites

Gardenia Blanco, Familia Torres PENEDES, SPAIN

Crisp, delicate aroma of peach, apricot and citrus notes, with a hint of vanilla spice. Refreshing and delicious.

Chardonnay ‘L’Artisan’ PAYS D’OC, FRANCE

Offers a quintessence of tropical fruits and floral aromas evolving towards honey, vanilla and lime blossom notes. This wine is generously rich and mellow.

Verdejo, Diez Siglos RUEDA, SPAIN

Intense aromas of stone fruit, tangerine oil and citrus. A rounded and complex palate, with peach and apricot fruit and notes of grass and fennel. Textural, though bright and pure with a long finish.

Organic Viognier ‘GEN’ Yalumba SOUTH AUSTRALIA

Certified by the Australian Certified Organic standards. It’s made without the use of chemical fertilisers and pesticides in the vineyard. The wine goes through wild fermentation, using only the natural yeasts present in the vineyard and on grape skins. The palate is rich and textured, full of exotic aromas and complex fruit flavours.

Complex, full or oaky whites

Bila Haut Blanc, Chapoutier CÔTES DU ROUSSILLION, FRANCE

Fresh and very aromatic on the nose. The palate is round, with a great acidity. A lot of freshness on the finish mixed with salty notes, which express the minerality of the wine.

Rioja Blanco “Monopole” Cune RIOJA, SPAIN

Aromas of spring flowers, pear, apple and white currant. The palate is silky and pleasing and the finish is long, fresh and youthful.

Chablis, William Fèvre BURGUNDY, FRANCE

Fèvre’s domaine bottling of Chablis is one of the benchmarks, offering classic Chablis aromas of crushed seashells and citrus fruits. The palate is prickly and fresh throughout, offering a real salinity and mineral focus to the finish













Eli Chardonnay MARLBOROUGH, NEW ZEALAND

Ripe melon and juicy pineapple characters on the nose. The sumptuous stone fruit melody is supported by toasty oak and a velvety butterscotch mouthfeel. The creamy caramel notes add for a warm finish and a touch of apparent sweetness.

Orange wine

Orgo Rkatsiteli, Kakheti Orange Wine KAKHETI, GEORGIA

Apricot to the eye, this wine has aromas of peach, lavender and thyme. There is a good balance of savory and fruit flavors—Granny Smith apple, rose petal, orange marmalade, dried herbs and clam shell. A bright finish breaks through a tight wall of chewy tannins.

Rosé Wine

Pinot Grigio Rosé “San Antonio” VENETO, ITALY

Very light and refreshing with delicate pear-drop fruit. Bright and fresh, terrifically easy to drink.

Pierre Chainier Rosé d’Anjou LOIRE, FRANCE

Watermelon pink, with summer pudding aromas on the nose. The medium-dry palate has red apple, some perfumed white peach with a balancing, refreshing acidity on the finish.

Rosé ‘Aurore’ “Côté Mas” SOUTHERN FRANCE

Cherry and redcurrants on the nose with just a hint of spring flowers. The palate is rich, smooth and balanced. Fruity with great length.

Côteaux d’Aix-En-Provence Rosé”#LOU”, Chateau Peyrassol

CÔTES DE PROVENCE, FRANCE

A blend of Cinsault, Grenache, and Syrah, this Provence Rosé is a perfect apéritif. Spicy on the nose with red berries, peach and a dry crisp finish.

Light, fresh reds

“Julia Florista” Tinto, Vidigal LISBOA, PORTUGAL

Bright ruby, medium-bodied and very easy drinking blend with elegantly spiced red fruit.

Valpolicella Classico “Lucchine”, Tedeschi VENETO, ITALY

The Tedeschi vineyards are set in the foot of the Pedemonte hills. This wine is fresh and lively with plump red fruits and a juicy lingering finish.

Beaune 1er Cru “Teurons”, Bouchard Père & Fils BURGUNDY, FRANCE

Complex bouquet of jammy red fruit, fig, peony with a hint of chocolate. Harmonious and deep palate, with a beautiful maturity and fine tannins.

Medium bodied, juicy fruit driven reds

Merlot ‘Tierra Alta’ CENTRAL VALLEY, CHILE

Plum, blackcurrent and cranberry aromas burst from the glass. The palate is juicy and fresh with soft red fruits and a hint of green pepper.

“Terra Boa” Old Wines, Bacalhoa BEIRAS, PORTUGAL

Aromas of ripe bramble fruit, plum and a touch of spice. Generous on the palate with fresh red cherry and blackberry leaf characters.

Cabernet Sauvignon, Ordinal, Côtes de Thau LANGUEDOC, FRANCE

A refreshing and fragrant Cabernet with fresh and bright flavours of blackcurrant. Silky textured, lifted on the mid-palate and with a smooth ripe finish.

Pinot Noir ‘L’Artisan’ PAYS D’OC, FRANCE

Light red garnet red with aromas of red fruits, morello cherries and raspberries. This wine is medium-bodied, perfectly balanced and generous with supple tannins

Barbera “150+1” Casali del Barone, Piemonte PIEMONTE, ITALY

Intense ruby red colour with ripe red fruit aromas. On the palate, it is full-bodied and round, with a soft finish of dark chocolate and black pepper.

“Clos Ancestral”, Familla Torres PENEDÈS, SPAIN

Garnet colour with ruby-red highlights. Expressive, with fine fruit notes (raspberry) and a floral (rose) nuance. Full of personality, with good presence on the palate, it opens up with intensity, then evolves in the glass to culminate in a subtle, refined finish.

Smooth, oaky and rich reds

Rioja Crianza “Cerro Anon” Bodegas Olarra RIOJA, SPAIN

A fine example of Rioja Crianza. Classic in style, rounded, spicy red fruits with vanilla aromas and a long, silky finish.

Château Surain BORDEAUX, FRANCE

A delicious Merlot dominated blend. Smooth tannins support a berry rich palate, hints of earth and spice enhance the finish.

Pinotage/Cabernet Sauvignon “Figurehead”, Raka wines

KLEIN RIVER, SOUTH AFRICA

Clear ruby colour. This Cape blend reveals raspberries and blackcurrant on the nose with a hint of spicy eucalyptus and caramelized banana from the Pinotage. Herbaceous black olives lead to a complex palate with ripe tannins and warm spice.

Cariñena/Garnacha/Syrah “Purgatori” Familia Torres COSTERS DEL SEGRE, SPAIN

Beautiful dark cherry red color. Exquisite red forest fruit (raspberry, redcurrant) aroma with deep, jammy undertones of cherry. Intense on the palate, with delicate, elegant, fine-grained tannins. A wine of exceptional personality.

Barolo Bussia, Dardi le Rose, Poderi Colla PIEMONTE, ITALY

Warm, open, sensuous nose with aromas of fresh red and dried fruits, leather, brown spices and delicate floral notes. The palate is generous, supple and approachable, combining freshness and youth with complexity, spice and fine-grained tannins.

Malbec, Quara Estate SALTA, ARGENTINA

Red cherries, blackcurrants and herbal aromas, soft tannins and subtle acidity support the well-rounded flavours of plums, mulberries and cherries.

Côtes du Rhône Villages “St Gervais Syrius “ Domaine Clavel RHONE, FRANCE

Expressive black fruits wrapped in silky tannins with a touch of oak. Juicy, spicy and perfect with red meat.

Grenache Bush Vine, Samuel’s Collection, Yalumba BAROSSA, AUSTRALIA

This light-bodied and highly aromatic wine shows the bright Barossa Grenache flavours at their individual best.

Côte-Rôtie “Brune et Blonde”, E. Guigal RHÔNE, FRANCE

An outstanding wine from this iconic Rhone producer. It has a mouth-watering core of blackberry and plum paste with layers of fruitcake, pastis and alder wood.

Sauvignon Blanc “Sweetheart”, Oliver Zeter PFALZ, GERMANY

Fruity, exotic and spicy with a refined acidity and fruit sweetness, breathtakingly delicious and zippy.

Mourvèdre “Late Harvest”, Cline Cellars CALIFORNIA, USA

This wine is luxuriously sweet and divinely tempting. Layers of chocolate, black berries and prunes. Great with chocolate.
